

COMMON MARKET LAW REVIEW PRIZE FOR YOUNG ACADEMICS 2023

The Editorial Board is pleased to announce that in 2023 there will be a Common Market Law Review Prize for an article submitted by a young or early career academic.

There will be a monetary prize of 500 euros, and the winning article will be published in Common Market Law Review.

Submissions for the 2023 prize may be on any subject in the area of EU law.

The Editorial Board will be looking for originality of thought, a significant contribution to existing scholarship, quality of analysis and research, and excellence in presentation.

In order to qualify as a young or early career academic, authors should in principle be aged 30 or under. Authors over the age of 30 are eligible if it is less than 3 years since they completed their PhD. Co-authored articles are admissible, provided both authors are young or early career academics.

The maximum number of words is 10,000, including footnotes.

The submission deadline is 31 October 2023. Submissions will not be considered before September 2023.
